













The Avampato Dicovery Museum took direct aim at communicating "really boring" health subjects by creating an "engaging experience" in a familiar format for its target audience – kids 10 to 15 years old. With a limited budget of \$630,000, the design team created an 80-person theater for the Museum that features a one or two person game, using a "television game show" format. Admitting "homage to *Hollywood Squares*," they created an entertainment-driven show/exhibit employing humor and three-dimensional animated characters representing parts of the body to deliver serious educational content. They have achieved an apparent seamlessness between pre-recorded show cues and the unpredictable behavior of museum guests.
